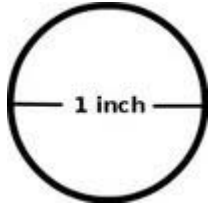

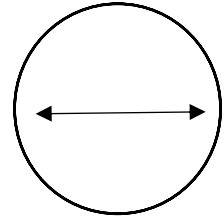
### BEFORE MEASURING



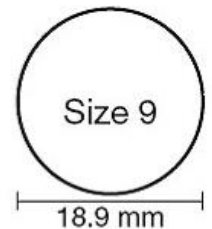
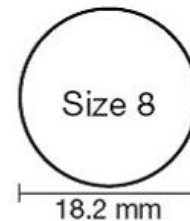
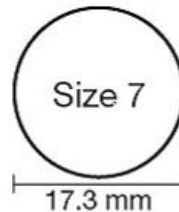
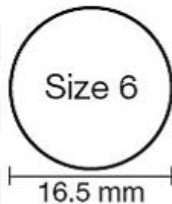
1. Carefully follow these instructions to accurately determine your ring size.
2. Prior to printing this guide, ensure that the Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box.
3. Measure the line on the left. It should be exactly 2 inches or 3 cm long.

### THE RING TEST

1. Find a ring that fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring on top of each of the circles below. The match should perfectly fit the inside of the ring. The measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
4. Double check for accuracy.
5. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.



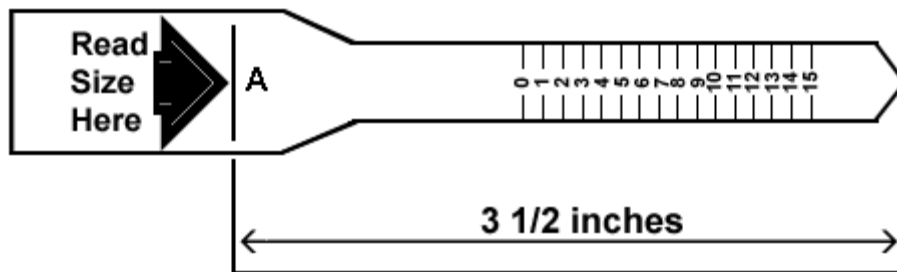

## The Paper Test

1. Wrap a slip of paper around the finger on which you will wear your ring.
2. Make sure you haven't wrapped the paper too loosely or too tightly. Aim for a snug fit.
3. Mark the paper where it meets and measure the distance with a ruler (mm)
4. Refer to the chart on the right to determine your ring size.
5. You can also print this guide and cut the paper ring sizer below.

## TIPS

### Measuring your finger

Measure your finger at the end of the day (fingers are smaller in the early morning).

Measure your finger multiple times to check for accuracy.

Don't measure your finger when your body temperature is either too hot or too cold.

Alcohol and salt can also make your fingers swell.

If you hesitate between two sizes, go for the larger one.
